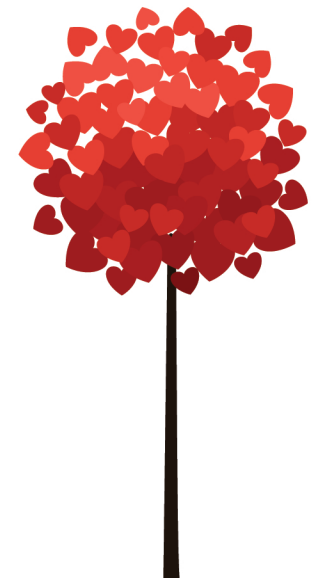

Our Vision



While 2011 was very challenging for the non-profit world with the Foundation and many other human service organizations experiencing substantial cuts in government and local funding, our Bar Foundation continued to thrive and provide many of the much-needed programs that serve not only the profession, but the community at large.

With the help of a grant from The Forbes Funds, we were able to hire a consultant to help us make our message more succinct in order to expand our reach to the bar and community and help raise sustainable funding to secure our place in the future.

We were able to streamline our work into three major areas of expertise: 1) Pro Bono; 2) Community Service; and, 3) support for our Profession.

Pro Bono. We use our unique skills as attorneys to support and provide pro bono services to low income individuals, families and children in Allegheny County to help them resolve their legal issues. Through our Pro Bono Center, over 850 dedicated and compassionate lawyers served as pro bono volunteers, and provided direct, advisory, and referral service to 9,000 indigent and low income clients in 2011. The Center worked in collaboration with 34 Pro Bono programs and organizations to help expand our services.

Community Service. The 2011-2012 Attorneys Against Hunger campaign raised over \$111,000, donating the funds to 16 local hunger related agencies. Through the generosity of Steidl and Steinberg, and Gleason & Associates, the campaign is fully underwritten. The Backpack Project provided 1,500 backpacks with supplies for underprivileged children. We provided \$25,000 in grants to public service organizations to support their pro bono initiatives and developed a mentoring program for at-risk girls at Auberle with the Women in the Law and Homer S. Brown divisions, and the Diversity Collaborative. This new program will launch in 2012.

Our Profession. The Foundation is committed to building a strong profession through law student scholarships, Public Interest Law Fellowship Program stipends, Louis Little loan program, and the Lawyers Fund. We honored 50 distinguished lawyers as new Fellows and Young Lawyers Fellows in the Class of 2011. We also welcomed 4 new Sustaining Fellows and 5 Patrons. The Foundation provided substantial support to our pro bono volunteers in the form of mentoring, education, volunteer opportunities, malpractice insurance and free legal research. We thanked our pro bono volunteers for their services through Pro Bono Awards and a recognition event.

Our fundraising efforts were a success despite the weak economy. The 2011 Golf Tournament at Sewickley Heights netted over \$38,000. Our third "Pro Bono Rocks" fundraising event included very competitive performances by a number of "lawyer bands" and successfully raised \$12,400.

On a sad note, the Foundation lost two members of its family in the past year. Eleanor Grainy, Director of the Juvenile Court Project, in August of 2011, and more recently, David Fawcett of Dickie McCamey & Chilcote, a Trustee of the Board, a Patron Fellow, and a passionate advocate for pro bono causes.

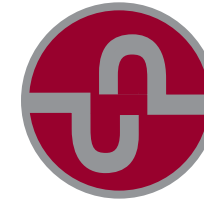

The Pro Bono Center is a vital resource for low-income Allegheny County residents in need of free legal assistance involving such basic human needs as housing, employment, family structure, and economic self-sufficiency. National and local studies have reported that legal services programs are able to assist only a fraction of those in need, leaving a huge gap in legal services. The Pro Bono Center's one-of-a-kind program has the ability to increase the number of well-trained volunteer attorneys and pro bono projects to make a significant impact on reducing this critical gap in services. The Center has the unique ability to leverage the over 6,400 members of the Allegheny County Bar Association and frequently engages member attorneys, judges, paralegals, and others in developing and supporting the delivery of legal services, resulting in collaborative projects that benefit clients, improve the function of the courts, and provide attorneys and paralegals with volunteer opportunities.

Delivering Innovative Legal Services



The Pittsburgh Pro Bono Partnership is a collaboration of legal departments, law firms, the Allegheny County Bar Foundation, and Neighborhood Legal Services Association. The Partnership encourages new and more creative efforts to provide legal services to persons of limited means and to organizations, including charities, which work on their behalf.

In 2011, the Partnership launched a new location for its Wills Clinic at the Bridgeville Public Library. Staffed and managed by the legal department of FedEx Ground, the clinic prepares essential documents for low-income seniors in the Bridgeville area. The Partnership also established a new site for a community legal clinic in Millvale, staffed by attorneys from Dickie McCamey & Chilcote, replacing a prior clinic in the area that had been closed. The Partnership welcomed Pollock Begg Komar Glasser as a new member.

Reaching Out

The Backpack Project

The Public Service Committee gathered donations of supplies and funds to fill 1,500 backpacks with essential back-to-school items for children. The backpacks were distributed through the Greater Pittsburgh Food Bank's Produce to People program.
